Week One

A Float Trip for Baby Moses

Exodus 1:1-2:10

God’s people, the Israelites, lived in Egypt, which was ruled by a mean pharaoh. Pharoah didn’t like the Israelites so he did something terrible. He ordered that all baby boys be thrown into the river, but there was a baby named Moses whose mom was clever and brave and kept him safe. God gave Moses many helpers to protect him because God gives us EVERYTHING we need.

Week Two

Birds and Bread from Heaven

Exodus 16

After Moses helped the Israelites escape Pharaoh, the Israelites became very hungry and they were upset. God provided them with meat to eat at night and bread to eat in the mornings. The Israelites had food to eat because God provided for them and He provides for us too!

Week Three

Clean Water in the Desert

Exodus 15:22-27

Moses helped the Israelites escape the mean pharaoh. But then they were so thirsty in the hot, dry desert. Moses prayed to God to ask for help and God provided the Israelites with clean water through a miracle! God gives us everything we need!

Week Four

The Ten Commandments - Love God

Exodus 19:1-20:11

God wanted to meet with Moses on top of a mountain. When Moses met with God, God gave him ten commandments, or rules. The kids will learn the first four commandments today.

Week Five

The Ten Commandments - Love God

Exodus 19:1-20:11

Moses went to the top of a mountain to meet with God and learned the ten commandments. When Moses came down from the mountain, he found the Israelites already breaking the first commandment - to worship God only.

Ask your child . . .

Week One

How can you be a helper to your friends and family?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of someone who helps you. While you are drawing, say a prayer and thank God for giving you helpers.

Week Two

What is something you love that God has given you?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of your favorite food. While you are drawing, say a prayer and thank God for giving you the food you eat.

Week Three

Can you tell me what God did in your Bible story today?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of your favorite shirt or dress. While you are drawing, say a prayer and thank God for giving you the clothes you wear.

Week Four

How can you show God love?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Think of a rule you have broken and draw a picture of it. While you are drawing, ask Jesus to forgive you for breaking God's rules.

Week Five

How many commandments are there? Can you tell me some of them?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a praise picture to Jesus. It can be anything that shows Jesus you love Him. Say a prayer and thank Jesus for loving you so much!
