God is great and mighty. 		Week One Crossing the Jordan River Joshua 3-4 "Great is our Lord. His power is mighty!" This week, preschoolers will hear how the Israelites crossed the Jordan River on dry ground! They'll learn that God is great and mighty.
		Week Two The Longest Day Ever Joshua 10:1-15 The perfect story for people who wish there were more hours in the day! This week, preschoolers will hear how God made the sun stand still for Joshua! They'll learn that God is great and mighty. If God made the sun stand still for you, what fun thing would you do with the extra time?
 “Great (pump hands in the air) is our Lord. (point up) His power (make muscle with one arm) is mighty.” (make muscle with other arm) Psalm 147:5 (open hands like a book)		Week Three David is Picked to be King 1 Samuel 16:1-13 "People look at the outside of a person. But the Lord looks at what is in the heart." (1 Samuel 16:7) This week, preschoolers will hear how young David was chosen to be king! They'll learn that God uses little people to do big things.
		Week Four David Fights the Big Bad Giant 1 Samuel 17 "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young." (1 Timothy 4:12) This week, preschoolers will hear the story of David and Goliath! They'll learn that God uses little people to do big things.

Preschool

Ask your child . . .

Week One

Can you tell me some great and mighty things God has done?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of something great God has given you. Say a prayer and thank God for giving you great things.

Week Two

Can you tell me what happened in your Bible story today?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of Jesus. Thank God for making Jesus alive again after He died on the cross. Now when we “mess up” we can say “I’m sorry” to Jesus and ask for His forgiveness.

Week Three

Why do you think God picked David to be king in your Bible story today?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of someone you know who needs to hear about Jesus. Say a prayer and ask God to help you do a BIG thing and tell that person about Jesus.

Week Four

When was a time you needed courage to do something?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of Goliath. While drawing, think about something that makes you feel afraid. Say a prayer and ask God to make you brave like little David when you are afraid.
