Week One

The Leper Who Said, “Thanks”

Luke 17:11-19

Jesus met ten very sick men who couldn't be near other people. They called out, “Jesus, help us!” Jesus loved them and told them to go show themselves to the priest. As they went, they were healed! While all ten men were healed, only one man came back to Jesus and said, “thank you.” This week, our preschoolers will learn that our thankful hearts matter to God.

Week Two

Jesus Feeds 4,000 People

Matthew 15:29-39

A huge crowd followed Jesus because they loved hearing Him teach and seeing Him help people. After several days, the people were very hungry. Jesus cared about them and didn't want them to go home without food. The disciples only had a few loaves of bread and some fish, but Jesus thanked God for the food and shared it. Everyone ate and was full. This week, our preschoolers will learn that God cares about our needs and we can say, “thank you!” to Him.

Week Three

Creation: Made in God's Image

Genesis 1-2

God creates the world and everything in it. His most precious creation is people, who He created in His image to look after the earth and to be in relationship with Him.

Week Four

The Fall

Genesis 3

Adam and Eve disobey God, believing the serpent's lie over God's truth. Still, God calls to them, cares for them, and promises that one of their descendants will someday defeat Satan once and for all.

Week Five

The Crucifixion

Matthew 27

Jesus is crucified on a cross to defeat sin and fix the relationship between people and God. His sacrifice demonstrates His amazing love for us!

Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of your favorite food. While you’re drawing, say a prayer and tell Jesus “thank you” for giving you food to eat.

Week Three

What is your favorite part of God’s creation?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of yourself. While drawing, say a prayer and tell Jesus “Thank You” for creating you and making you in His image.

Week Four

What did God tell Adam and Eve they were not allowed to do?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of a fruit. While you’re drawing, say a prayer and tell Jesus “thank You” for never giving up on us and forgiving us.

Week Five

What did Jesus do first when He was in the garden after the meal with His disciples?



Deeper in the conversation

Encourage your child to respond to the following prompt:

Draw a picture of a cross. While you’re drawing, say a prayer and tell Jesus “thank You” for dying for us so we could be forgiven.

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
