This Month’s Theme is . . .		
God is Good   FOUNDATIONS FROM GOD’S WORD THAT EVERY KID SHOULD KNOW. “God created people (POINT UP) in His own image, (FRAME YOUR FACE WITH YOUR HANDS) male and female, He created them.” (PUT ONE HAND ON ONE SIDE AND THE OTHER HAND ON THE OTHER SIDE, THEN BRING BOTH HANDS TOGETHER IN FRONT OF YOU.) Genesis 1:27 (OPEN HANDS LIKE A BOOK)	Week One Abram and Lot Genesis 12-15 God is in Control. God made a covenant with Abram, telling him to go to a new land. Abram let Lot choose land first. Lot chose the best but later needed rescuing. God reminded Abram of His promise and faithfulness.	
	Week Two Psalms of Wisdom Psalms 19; Genesis 1 God is Good. Wisdom psalms guide us in how God wants us to live. David celebrates how God reveals Himself through both nature and His Word. God’s creation shows us how good God is. We can praise God and seek Him daily.	
	Week Three Psalms of Lament Psalms 22; Esther 2-8 God is good, even when we are hurting. Psalms of lament express sadness, frustration or even complaints to God. Psalm 22 encourages us to share all our emotions to God and remember His goodness and faithfulness. Esther shows us that no matter how we feel, we can still have hope. God can help us; He is faithful to keep His promises. We can praise God, knowing His goodness and holiness never end.	
	Week Four Psalms of Trust Psalms 23:1; 1 Samuel 16 God is our Good Shepherd. Before David was chosen as king, he was a shepherd boy. In Psalm 23, David compares God to a shepherd. A shepherd guides, comforts and provides for those in his care. The psalms of trust highlight God’s protection and care, encouraging us to trust in Him.	
	Week Five Psalms of Thanksgiving Psalms 136; John 6:1-15 God does good things for His people. The psalmist walks through the history of Israel, from creation to God’s rescue in the promised land. We can thank God for His eternal goodness and His never-failing love. The feeding of the 5,000 is a reminder of God’s goodness to provide and how we can always give Him thanks.

Talk about something difficult you have faced as a family. Discuss how God was good through the tough situation.

Week Four

What does a shepherd do? Who is the Good Shepherd?



Deeper in the conversation



As a family, list all the ways a good shepherd takes care of sheep. Talk about how God, as our Good Shepherd, is like this.

Week Five

Why is being thankful to God so important?



Deeper in the conversation



Create a Thankful book and record things that you are thankful for as a family.
